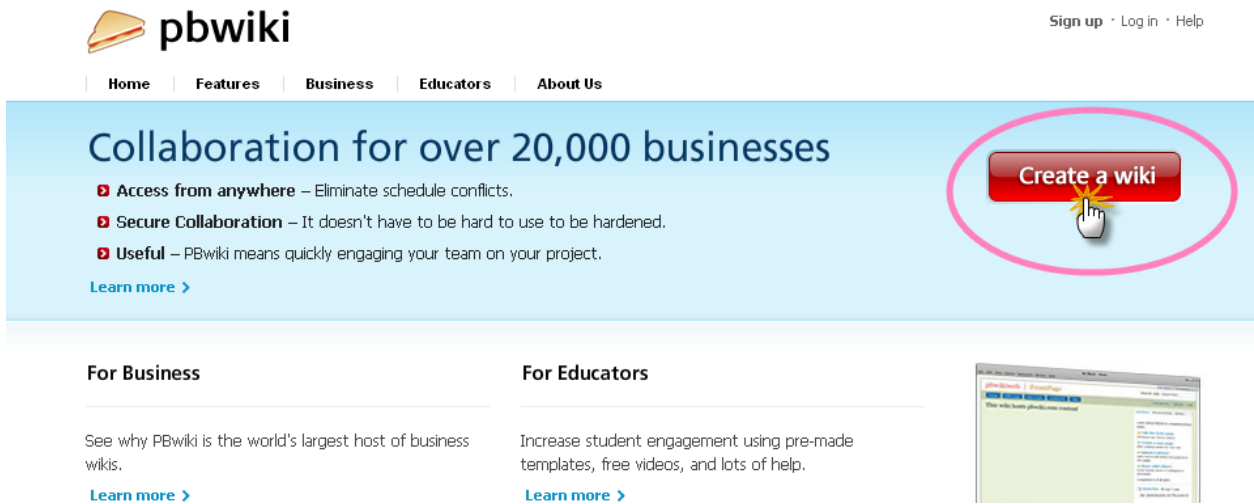


How to make a wiki using PBwiki

1. Go to <http://pbwiki.com/>
2. Click on **Create a Wiki**



3. Fill out the three steps of information on the next page. The **Site Name** will become your wiki URL. So if your site name is “bearcats” then the address (URL) for your wiki will be <http://bearcats.pbwiki.com>. You will also need to give your email address and select the type of wiki you are creating from the drop down menu. Answer those three questions and click on **Create my wiki!**

4. After you create your wiki, the next page will say, “Yum! That was easy!” In order to proceed you need to check your email for a confirmation. In the email there will be a link you have to click on

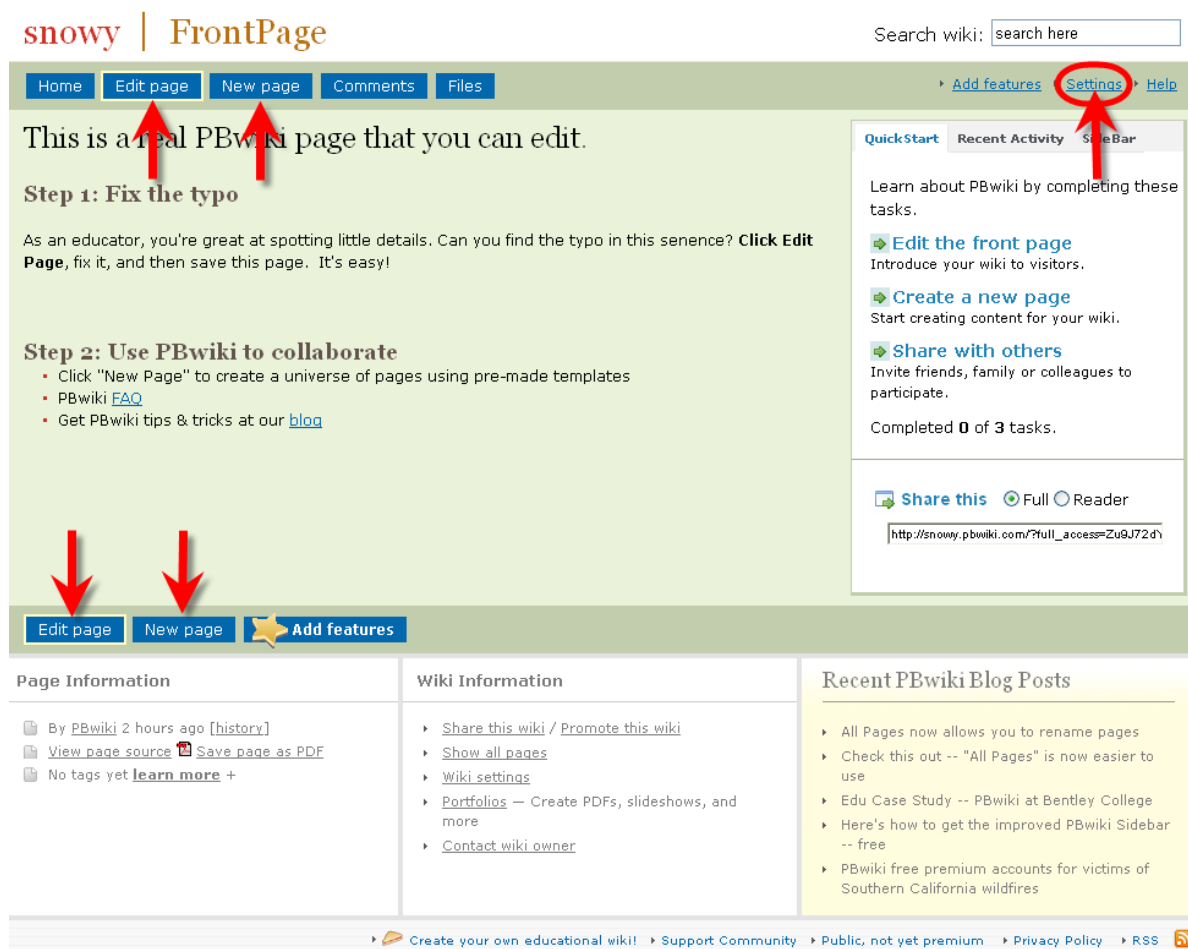
to get to your wiki. Your wiki is not officially made and confirmed until you click on that link. The page that comes up through the link is shown below.

5. On the webpage that appears from the email link, you must pick a password for your wiki. The wiki can only be edited by someone if they know the password.
6. Who can access your wiki is not about editing the wiki. For editing, a password is always needed. This question is about who can see your wiki.
7. Check the little box that says you agree to their terms of service and you can leave the “new point and click editor” option the way it is. Then, click on **Next: Choose wiki features**.
8. The next screen that appears will offer upgrade packages. Scroll down a little and click on “No thanks, just take me to my wiki” in the “Continue trying out the free version” area.

9. You are done with the set up portion and can now move on to editing your wiki! The first wiki page you see looks like the screen shot below. To edit the page, click on **Edit Page**. To make a new page in your wiki, click on **New Page**.
